Dry red wine, made entirely from Pinot Noir, aged in French oak. Label named in honour of Pope Benedict XIV who granted Carastelec village the right to hold a festival on Holy Cross Day in 1754.

WINEMAKING AND TASTING NOTES

The wine has a fine ruby color, exhibits intense aromas of red fruits, ripe cherries, raspberries and blackberries, with a subtle hint of vanilla and tobacco. Its delicate body and fine tannins harmonize perfectly with the wine's acidity. The red fruit aromas, combined with the earthy flavors characteristic of Pinot Noir, culminate in a persistent, spicy aftertaste.

"VINCA is the brand dedicated to still wines. The chosen symbol is the stylized flower of the periwinkle, or in Latin, Vinca Minor. The etymology comes from the word vincere, which means "to conquer." Vinca conquers winter with its vibrant leaves and brings color to spring, symbolizing the rebirth of nature and the vineyard. Vinca is the symbol of a new beginning.
